**Event Name:** TEAM RELAY (cyclo-cross loop without barriers)  
**Event Date:** May 26, 2016  
**Event Location:** Centennial Park Log Cabin  
**Parking Directions:** Centennial Park Parking Lot

New\* because this race is so short, with many riders doing sub 2min laps, we will add a second lap for each rider. The modified lap order would be: Rider 1,2,3,1,2,3 (so the first rider does lap 1 & 4; rider #2 does laps 2 & 5; and the final rider does laps 3 & 6)

\*Mixed riders for SPORT race may be male, female, and any age. Any rider who participated in any of races 2,3 or 4 is eligible to participate in this event.

\*Each team will consist of 3 riders

\*athletes may be "moved up" to make a team. (example: moving up a midget girl and a jr girl to compete with your lone Sr girl will earn points in the Sr division.)  
Athletes may not move down a category.

\*Only team points (ex. Jr Girls & overall) are earned in this race. Not individual points.

\*A school may enter multiple teams in an event, but only one scores points. (Example: School A's teams finish 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> while school B's team finishes 3<sup>rd</sup>- school A would get 20pts for winning, the 16pts for second place would be scratched & the 13 pts for 3<sup>rd</sup> place would go to school B)

### Event Instructions

- Please advise riders not to ride their bikes in the parking lot or around the chalet area. We have to be aware of the general public at this location.
- Report any injured riders immediately to on course marshals or finish line crew.
- When returning to the start line after your race is finished riders must use the train tracks to prevent riding into an on coming race.
- The course is open to the general public and riders must watch for pedestrians at all times.
- MG, JG and SG will have different colour flagging tape on their seat post to differentiate between the different categories.
- Washroom facilities will be available at the chalet
